ORDER RE SCHEDULE

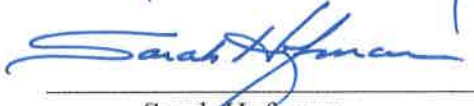
On July 30, 2018, Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) filed on behalf of the parties a stipulated motion to alter the schedule in this proceeding. GMP states that the schedule change is necessary because the Department of Public Service (“DPS”) requested a one-week extension to file testimony in this matter. GMP states that the proposed schedule accommodates both the DPS’s request and the Vermont Public Utility Commission’s desire to schedule the evidentiary hearing for October 25 and 26, reserving October 29 if necessary.

The motion is granted and the following schedule is adopted:

October 19, 2018	Responses to Discovery due from DPS and intervenors
October 25, 26, 2018	Evidentiary hearing
November 16, 2018	Initial briefs due to be filed
November 27, 2018	Reply briefs due to be filed
