**PROCEDURAL ORDER RE: DPS REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME**




On July 24, 2018, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed (1) a status update on energy efficiency utility (“EEU”) administrative efficiency minimum performance requirements (“MPR”) for the 2018-2020 performance period, and (2) a request on behalf of itself, Vermont Energy Investment Corporation (operating as Efficiency Vermont), the City of Burlington Electric Department, and Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. (collectively, the “Movants”), for more time for the EEUs to develop proposals identifying and defining administrative costs and how they would be tracked and reported. The Department noted the progress achieved with the EEUs in analyzing and agreeing upon proposals for many EEU administrative costs, and requested additional time to address the remaining costs. Accordingly, the Movants requested an extension until September 28, 2018, to file their administrative efficiency MPR proposals.

No comments on the request were filed.

Each EEU has an approved quantifiable performance indicator (“QPI”) that is intended to define and track EEU administrative costs. To meet the QPI, each EEU was required to submit by July 31, 2018, a proposal on how to track and report administrative costs and to include a metric on the ratio of incentive costs to non-incentive costs and total administrative costs as a percent of total budget for the performance period. The request for additional time is granted. The deadline for filing administrative efficiency MPR proposals is extended until September 28, 2018.


