Re: **Change of Date for Workshop**
Date: September 4, 2018

The date of the **Workshop** in this Case No. 17-4632-INV, originally scheduled for Monday, September 17, 2018, **has been changed to Friday, September 28, 2018 at 9:30 A.M.**

As discussed in the prior memorandum, the purpose of the workshop is to discuss what activities constitute incremental fossil-fuel reductions under 30 V.S.A. § 8005(a)(3)(E)(ii) and when such reductions must occur to count towards Tier III requirements. At the workshop, the Commission asks that WEC and Capstone provide additional explanation regarding the following:

1. Whether the model followed by WEC and Capstone for their 2017 Tier III energy savings (i.e., energy-saving renovations, MWhs claimed, payment for savings, and then completion of additional activity) is the appropriate order of activities for weatherization programs;
2. Whether federal laws and rules always require that any additional revenue a community-action group such as Capstone receives for its weatherization activity must be the next dollars expended toward the weatherization of additional units, ahead of grant dollars, and
3. Whether the parties think any statutory changes may be needed to clarify Section 8005(a)(3)(E)(ii) or better align the Section with the needs of the federal Weatherization Assistance Program.

The other parties to this proceeding are also invited to provide comment on the foregoing issues and any related issues.

The workshop will be held in the Susan M. Hudson Hearing Room, Third Floor, People's United Bank Building, 112 State Street, Montpelier, VT 05620. The workshop will be recorded by a court reporter and will be open to the public. The above workshop location is ADA-accessible. Handicapped parking is available in the People's United Bank parking lot at 112 State Street, behind the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food, and Markets at 116 State Street,
