PROCEDURAL ORDER ESTABLISHING COMMENT DEADLINES

On October 4, 2018, Salisbury AD 1, LLC (“Salisbury AD 1”), filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) a motion to transfer the Section 248 certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued to Lincoln Renewable Gas, LLC in Docket 8596 to Salisbury AD 1, a motion to amend the CPG, and a petition under 30 V.S.A. § 231 for a CPG for Salisbury AD 1 to own and operate a renewable natural gas facility and for de minimis regulation.

In accordance with 30 V.S.A. § 231, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) shall file a recommendation on the Section 231 petition setting forth reasons why the petition shall be accepted without a hearing or requesting that a hearing on the petition be scheduled. In accordance with the statute, the Department shall file its recommendation within 12 days of the date the petition was filed, or by October 16, 2018.

In regard to the motion for an amended Section 248 CPG, pursuant to Commission Rule 5.408, comments on the motion shall address whether the proposed amendments constitute a substantial change. A substantial change is a change in the approved proposal that has the potential for significant impact with respect to any of the Section 248(b) criteria or on the general good of the state under Section 248(a). Parties to Docket 8596 shall file comments on the motion for an amended CPG by no later than October 24, 2018.

In regard to the motion to transfer the Section 248 CPG to Salisbury AD 1, parties in Docket 8596 shall file comments on the proposed transfer by October 24, 2018.
