**PROCEDURAL ORDER EXTENDING COMMENT DEADLINE FOR THE VERMONT DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC SERVICE UNDER 30 V.S.A. § 231**

On October 4, 2018, Salisbury AD 1, LLC (“Salisbury AD 1”), filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) a motion to transfer the Section 248 certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued to Lincoln Renewable Gas, LLC in Docket 8596 to Salisbury AD 1, a motion to amend the CPG, and a petition under 30 V.S.A. § 231 for a CPG for Salisbury AD 1 to own and operate a renewable natural gas facility and for de minimis regulation.

On October 11, 2018, I confirmed the deadline for the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) to file its recommendation on the Section 231 petition, and established different deadlines for filing comments on the motions.

On October 16, 2018, the Department requested an extension of its Section 231 filing deadline to October 24, 2018, which is the deadline for filing any comments on the motions. The Department represents that Salisbury AD 1 has no objection to the requested extension.

Accordingly, I grant the Department’s request for an extension to file its Section 231 recommendations by October 24, 2108.

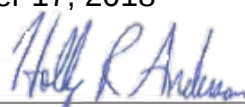
