THIRD PROCEDURAL ORDER EXTENDING COMMENT DEADLINES

UNDER 30 V.S.A. § 231 AND § 248

On October 4, 2018, Salisbury AD 1, LLC (“Salisbury AD 1”), filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) a motion to transfer the Section 248 certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued to Lincoln Renewable Gas, LLC in Docket 8596 to Salisbury AD 1, a motion to amend the CPG, and a petition under 30 V.S.A. § 231 for a CPG for Salisbury AD 1 to own and operate a renewable natural gas facility and for de minimis regulation.

On October 11, 2018, I issued a procedural order establishing comment deadlines, and on October 17 and October 23, 2018, I issued procedural orders extending the comment deadlines at the request of the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) and the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (“ANR”).

On October 29, 2018, the Department filed a motion for an extension of the comment deadlines to November 7, 2018. The Department represents that ANR, Salisbury AD 1, and Lincoln Renewable Natural Gas, LLC, have no objections to the requested extension.

Accordingly, I grant the request for an extension of the Department’s deadline to file its Section 231 recommendation and for other participants to file comments on the proposed CPG transfer and CPG amendment by November 7, 2018.
