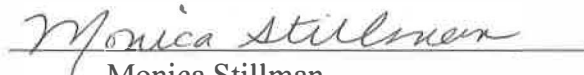
I hereby adopt the following schedule as proposed by the parties:

Salisbury AD 1 files stipulations and proposal for decision	February 5, 2019
Department files testimony or comment letter	February 12, 2019
<i>If all issues resolved:</i>	
Evidentiary hearing (if required)	February 18, 2019
<i>If contested issues remain:</i>	
Status conference to set litigation schedule	February 18, 2019

This schedule includes a short time-frame between the deadline for motions to intervene (January 4, 2019) and the deadline for the first round of discovery on Salisbury AD 1 (January 8, 2019). Salisbury AD 1 agrees to respond to discovery requests from potential intervenors prior to the Commission ruling on their intervention requests.
