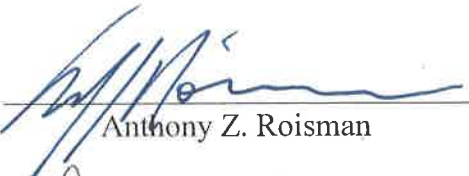
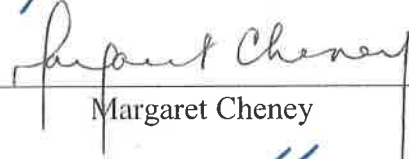
AMENDMENT OF DEADLINE FOR COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

In an order dated December 21, 2018, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) approved an approximate 5.43% increase in the base rates of Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) and directed GMP to submit a revised cost of service and revised tariffs within two business days. On the same date, the Commission approved certain rate design changes in Case No. 18-2850-TF (“Rate Design Order”). The Rate Design Order required GMP to file revised tariffs implementing the approved rate design and “any other tariff changes approved by the Commission in related cases” within 10 days.

On December 24, 2018, GMP filed a revised cost of service. GMP stated that it “will be preparing blended tariff sheets which cover the rate adjustment authorized in Case No. 18-0974-TF, as well as the rate design adjustments authorized in Case No. 18-2850-TF and will file copies of the tariffs in the investigation subcase for each matter before January 3, 2019.” GMP is relieved of the requirement that it file revised tariffs within 2 business days of the December 21 Order. GMP may file a single set of revised tariff sheets reflecting the rate adjustment authorized in this case, as well as the rate design adjustments authorized in Case No. 18-2850-TF before January 3, 2019.
