ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

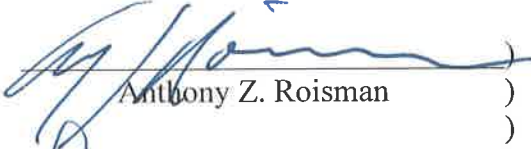
On January 3, 2019, Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) filed updated tariff sheets reflecting the rate adjustments and rate design approved by the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on December 21, 2018, in the two above captioned cases.

On January 7, 2019, the Department of Public Service filed a letter recommending that the Commission approve the tariff revisions without a hearing or further investigation, effective with bills rendered January 3, 2019.

The Commission has reviewed GMP’s updated tariff sheets and concludes that they reflect the approved rate adjustments and rate design. Accordingly, we hereby approve the tariff revisions without further investigation or hearing. The tariff sheets shall be in effect for bills rendered on and after January 3, 2019.
