SECOND PROCEDURAL ORDER RE SCHEDULE

On January 11, 2019, Salisbury AD 1, LLC (“Salisbury AD 1”) filed a request for changes to the schedule for the proceedings in this case that was adopted by order dated December 5, 2018. Salisbury AD 1 represents that the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources and the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets (“AAFM”) have no objections to the proposed changes.¹ The Vermont Department of Public Service filed comments on January 11, 2019, stating that it has no objection to the proposed schedule changes. The proposed changes are to accommodate and/or resolve conflicts with holidays in the original schedule.

The following schedule based on the parties’ proposal is adopted with two revisions. I have tentatively scheduled the evidentiary hearing for February 22. However, I am holding an alternate date for the hearing on March 14 in the event I need additional time to review the parties’ filings and prepare for a hearing if one is needed. I have also provided a date for the parties to file either stipulated or separate litigation schedules and any requests for a status conference if contested issues remain.

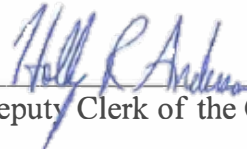
