CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD (“CPG”)
ISSUED PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 231

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) of the State of Vermont on this day found and adjudged that the issuance of a Certificate of Public Good (“CPG”) to Champlain Broadband, LLC (the “CPG Holder”) for the provision of telecommunications services, including local exchange service and intrastate and interstate long distance phone service, and internet access will promote the general good of the State of Vermont.

In doing business in the State of Vermont, the CPG Holder shall comply with the following conditions:

1. The CPG Holder is subject to the provisions of Title 30, Vermont Statutes Annotated, and the Commission’s Order in Docket No. 5808 to the extent consistent with federal law and to the same extent as other regulated utilities.
2. The CPG Holder may participate in any Commission investigation into local competition or competitive access services. The CPG Holder shall be bound to comply with any lawful requirement imposed by the Commission in Docket 5713 (and follow-on proceedings), Docket 5903, and Docket 5918, any docket or rule established with respect to E-911 service, and any other docket or rulemaking proceeding governing the obligations of telecommunications carriers in Vermont.
3. The CPG Holder shall terminate all telecommunications traffic routed to its customers by any telecommunications carrier with which it interconnects.

4. The CPG Holder's books, accounts, statements, and other financial records shall, in accordance with Vermont law, be made available for examination by the Commission or the Vermont Department of Public Service ("Department").

5. This CPG may not be transferred to any other party without prior approval by the Commission.

6. The CPG Holder is authorized to do business in Vermont under the name Burlington Telecom. If the CPG Holder conducts business in Vermont under any other name, it shall file a notice of the new trade name with the Commission and the Department at least 15 days before commencing business under the new trade name.

7. If the CPG Holder at any time in the future proposes to offer operator services, it shall be required to comply with Commission Rule 7.609(G).

8. If the CPG Holder, at any time in the future, proposes to offer prepaid calling services, it shall post a bond, payable to the Commission, in an amount equivalent to the projected Vermont intrastate revenues from its prepaid calling service for the first 12 months of operation.

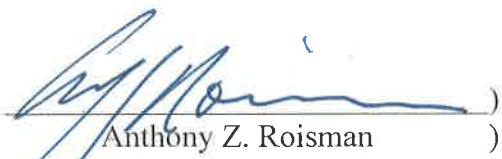
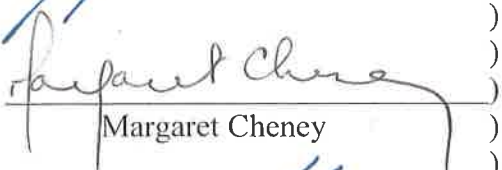
9. The CPG Holder's telecommunications services shall be subject to the Docket 5903 reporting requirements.

10. To the extent consistent with federal law, the CPG Holder shall be subject to any rules lawfully adopted or to be adopted by the Commission.

11. The CPG Holder's CPG shall be subject to revocation upon good cause, including a substantial or continuous failure to abide by its material terms.

12. The CPG Holder shall provide consumer protection information to its customers and shall ensure that its customer service representatives comply with all relevant statutes and Commission Orders and Rules.
