PROCEDURAL ORDER MODIFYING SCHEDULE AND CANCELLING STATUS CONFERENCE

This case concerns the petition of Salisbury AD 1, LLC (“Applicant”) for proposed amendments to the Section 248 certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued by the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) for a renewable natural gas facility at the Goodrich Farm on Shard Villa Road in Salisbury, Vermont (the proposed amended “Project”).

On January 22, 2019, I revised the schedule for this case, which included an evidentiary hearing or status conference on February 22, 2019, if necessary, and an alternative tentative date for an evidentiary hearing on March 14, 2019.

On February 7, 2019, I cancelled the tentative evidentiary hearing scheduled for February 22, directed the Applicant to file additional information, provided notice of a possible status conference to be held on February 22, and directed the parties to file any requests for a status conference by February 20.

On February 8, 2019, the Applicant filed a response to my Order dated February 7.

On February 15, 2019, I directed the Applicant to file a revised blasting plan.

On February 19, 2019, the Applicant filed a revised blasting plan.

On February 19, 2019, the Vermont Department of Public Service filed comments stating that it does not object to the Applicant’s request that no hearing be held.

No other parties filed any comments regarding the Applicant’s supplemental filings or the tentatively scheduled evidentiary hearing or status conference.

Accordingly, I am cancelling the status conference that was scheduled for February 22, 2019. I also determine that there is no need for the evidentiary hearing tentatively scheduled for March 14, 2019.
