On December 11, 2019, Southern Vermont Cable Company (“SVCC”) and Comcast of Georgia/Massachusetts/New Hampshire/New York/North Carolina/Virginia/Vermont, LLC, d/b/a Comcast (“Comcast”) (collectively, the “Petitioners”), filed with the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) a joint petition for approval of the following: (1) acquisition by Comcast of the cable television system owned and operated by SVCC; (2) revocation of SVCC’s Certificate of Public Good (“CPG”); and (3) issuance of a new CPG to Comcast to serve the

towns of Newfane, Putney, Townshend and Dover. The Department of Public Service (“Department”) is currently reviewing the joint petition, prefiled testimony and exhibits.
