**JOINT UPDATE REGARDING PUBLIC HEARING LOCATION AND DATE AND
NOTICE OF JOINT PETITION TO SVCC CUSTOMERS**

On January 10, 2020, the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) held a scheduling conference in this matter. Present at the scheduling conference were representatives from the Department of Public Service (“Department”), Southern Vermont Cable Company (“SVCC”) and Comcast of Georgia/Massachusetts/New Hampshire/New York/North Carolina/Virginia/Vermont, LLC, d/b/a Comcast (“Comcast”). Pursuant to the Commission’s request, the parties are providing an update regarding the date and location of the proposed

public hearing as well as an update on the method of notice of the joint petition to SVCC customers.

The parties have confirmed the location and date of the public hearing. The public hearing will be held at the O'Brien Auditorium located in the East Academic Building at Landmark College, 19 River Road South, in Putney, Vermont on February 3, 2020 from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. The Department will host a 30-minute informational session beginning at 4:00 p.m. at the O'Brien Auditorium followed immediately by the public hearing. At the request of the Department, SVCC has agreed to provide via U.S. mail a notice of the joint petition to SVCC customers on or before Monday, January 20, 2020.

The parties request that the Commission adopt a full schedule as jointly proposed on January 7, 2020.
