MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

NOW COMES Vermont Public Power Supply Authority (“VPPSA”), by and through its attorneys, McNeil, Leddy & Sheahan, P.C., and pursuant to Rule 6(b) of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure, made applicable to this proceeding by Rule 2.207 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice, hereby moves the Commission to enlarge the time by which VPPSA must file its direct testimony from February 21, 2020 to February 28, 2020. In support of this Motion, VPPSA states as follows:

1. The Commission’s Scheduling Order in the above-captioned matter dated January 31, 2020, establishes a deadline of February 21, 2020 for VPPSA to file testimony and proposals.
2. The undersigned was informed today that a VPPSA witness has been ill and unable to prepare testimony due to her illness.
3. Counsel for Vermont Energy Investment Corporation has been contacted by the undersigned and he has no objection to VPPSA’s one-week extension request provided it applies solely to VPPSA.
4. VPPSA has agreed to cooperate with VEIC in responding to discovery to minimize any impacts on the existing schedule.

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5. The Commission's Order Re: Practice Regarding Requests for Deadline

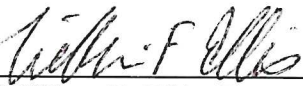
Extensions dated July 14, 2017, provides in part that extension requests made less than three business days before the subject deadline will only be granted for good cause shown.

6. VPPSA submits that good cause has been shown in that a witness has been unable to prepare testimony due to an illness, this motion was made the same day as the undersigned was informed of this illness, and the extension will have minimal, if any, impact on the existing schedule.

WHEREFORE, VPPSA respectfully requests that the Commission enlarge the date by which VPPSA must file direct testimony from February 21, 2020 to February 28, 2020.
