DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE MOTION TO ALTER SCHEDULE

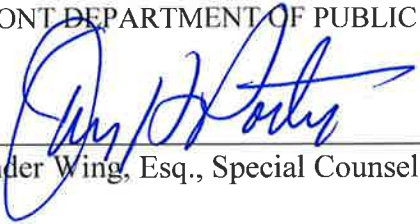
By Memorandum of January 16, 2020, the Hearing Officer requested that the Department would file its proposed Rule by no later than March 1, 2020.
