PROCEDURAL ORDER SETTING DEADLINES

On July 7, 2020, Salisbury AD 1, LLC (the “CPG Holder”) filed a motion to amend its certificate of public good (“CPG”) to reflect changes to the approved Salisbury Renewable Natural Gas Facility (the “Project”).

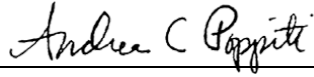
On July 24, 2020, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed comments on the motion and the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (“ANR”) filed its response to the motion to amend. The Department requests that the CPG Holder respond to several questions concerning the motion to amend. The Department requests at least three weeks to submit further comments, recommendations, or requests after the CPG Holder files its response.

The CPG Holder is directed to file its reply to the Department’s comments and questions and to ANR’s response by August 5, 2020. The CPG Holder should file additional testimony and exhibits to support its reply as necessary.

The Department and ANR are requested to file further comments, recommendations, or requests by no later than August 26, 2020. Within two weeks after reviewing these additional filings, the CPG Holder is directed to file either: (1) a proposed order approving the issuance of an amended CPG and a proposed amended CPG, or (2) a proposed litigation schedule in the event that additional process is necessary for resolution of the amendment request.

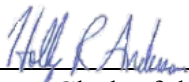
