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THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE'S MOTION TO RESCHEDULE

On April 16, 2020, the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("Commission") stayed this biennial update under Rule 5.128, given the extensive and unknown impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, until August 3, 2020. Per the Commission's order, Vermont's distribution electric utilities were directed to file net-metering data from January 2, 2020 to July 1, 2020 by the August 3, 2020 reopening of these proceedings. The Commission provided August 17, 2020 as the date by which participants might file additional comments or information.

The Department of Public Service requests that participants be given until August 31, 2020 to file any additional information or comments. Given the time that has passed during the stay, and more importantly, the extensive impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, this extension of two weeks would enable participants to more effectively comment on the effects on COVID-19 on Vermont's net-metering program and its role in the State's economy.
