

Instructions for Participating in the Review of the Attached Net-Metering Registration

For systems that are 15 kW or less, there is a 10-business-day comment period. (The computation of the number of business days does not include weekends, state legal holidays under 1 V.S.A. § 371(a), or federal legal holidays under 5 U.S.C. § 6103(a).) For systems greater than 15 kW, there is a 30-calendar-day comment period.

Objections to the installation of the facility may be filed with the Commission via the Commission's online document management system, known as ePUC, which you can access on the Commission's website at puc.vermont.gov or mailed to the Commission at 112 State Street, 4th Floor, Montpelier, VT 05620-2701. If you use ePUC to file your objection, ePUC will automatically provide notice of and access to your filing to all other parties. If you mail your objection to the Commission, you must also mail a copy of your filing to all other parties in the case.

If an objection to the installation of the facility is filed, the applicant may not commence installation of the project until the issues raised in the objection have been resolved. If no objections to the installation of the project are timely filed with the Commission, a certificate of public good shall be deemed issued by the Commission on the first business day following the expiration of the applicable comment period. The applicant may not commence site preparation or installation of the system until the applicable comment period has expired.

- (6) if this project has a capacity of greater than 15 kW, as required by State law, within 45 days of the date that a certificate of public good (CPG) for the project is deemed issued, I shall record a notice of the CPG in the land records of the host municipality using the Certificate of Public Good Municipal Notice Form that is available on the Commission’s website at <http://puc.vermont.gov/document/cpg-municipal-notice-form>. I shall file proof of this recording with the Commission;
- (7) if I am a system installer, the Applicant has authorized me to submit this registration form on behalf of the Applicant and the Applicant has signed a binding contract for the installation; and
- (8) I have paid the required Department/Commission Application Fee to the Department of Public Service.

Making false or misleading statements on this application is subject to penalties under 30 V.S.A. § 30 and/or revocation of any approval granted.
