**PROPOSED REVISIONS TO VERMONT PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION RULE 2**

As a landowner and someone who has experienced first-hand the process involved in approving and monitoring a wind development project governed by a CPG, I urge all those persons making future decisions under Rule 2 to consider the needs of the common Vermonter and the environmental justice issues identified in my opening comments. As a non-lawyer, who sincerely represents the voices of neighbors and friends, the process must be one that invites public participation. Most of the comments that I have read thus far address “lawyerly” concerns that will have little if any consequence in the intended purpose of the proposed revisions to Commission Rule 2. While many of those concerns are accurate and may indeed be correctly identified, they are of little use in protecting meaningful access for the common person to engage in a straightforward and uncomplicated process.

I look forward to further discussion on all matters raised by all the participants and particularly to explore the questions I raised in my original comments.
