**PROCEDURAL ORDER RE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE EXHIBITS**

On February 23, 2021, I issued an order that, in part, overruled objections by the respondent, David Blittersdorf, to the proposed admission of certain documents into the evidentiary record of this proceeding by the Department of Public Service (“Department”).


On March 5, 2021, the Department filed a revised list of the documents that it intends to offer into evidence at the March 18, 2021, evidentiary hearing. The list consists of documents that were either authored or sponsored by Mr. Blittersdorf as part of filings he made in this proceeding, or are documents authored and filed by Mr. Blittersdorf’s attorney on Mr. Blittersdorf’s behalf.

In spite of Mr. Blittersdorf’s connection to these documents, he has declined to stipulate to their admission into the evidentiary record. As a result, it has been left to the Department to offer these documents into evidence.

Because the documents will be offered by the Department, and not Mr. Blittersdorf, I am instructing the Department to treat each document it intends to offer as a Department exhibit. Therefore, the Department must place an exhibit sticker on each document or set of documents that it intends to offer into the evidentiary record during the March 18 evidentiary hearing, mark them for identification, and create a list containing each document along with the newly assigned exhibit number and a description of each exhibit. The Department shall file each of the newly marked exhibits and its exhibit list in ePUC no later than Monday, March 15, 2021.
