**Re: 21-1054-NM rb Technologies, LLC: Application for a Certificate of  
Public Good Response to GMP Comments dated April 6, 2021**

Dear Ms. Anderson:

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the comments (“Comments”) filed by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) on April 6, 2021 regarding the net-metering application for rb Technologies, LLC (the “Applicant”) for a 44.2kW groundmount project in East Montpelier (the “Project”).

As GMP noted in its Comments, effective July 1, 2019, the Commission approved a tariff establishing a one-time fee of \$37/kW on all interconnection applications (the “shared TGFOV fee”). Per GMP, the Applicant may interconnect after payment of the shared TGFOV fee of \$1,635.40 is made to GMP. The Applicant agrees to pay the shared TGFOV fee.

In its Comments, GMP indicated that the inverters for this Project must comply with the “Inverter Source Requirement Document of ISO New England (ISO-NE SRD).” The Applicant confirms that the inverters used for the Project will comply with the aforementioned requirements.

GMP also indicated in its Comments that to interconnect safely and reliably, the Project requires an upgraded distribution transformer. The Applicant confirms this will be upgraded at the cost of the Project, and a safe and reliable connection will be made for this service.

Finally, GMP stated, “because the project is interconnecting to a substation with a load to generation ratio less than 1.5:1, it may not interconnect until system upgrades are completed. The project is subject to the shared TGFOV fee and completion of the Commission process for approval. GMP will communicate the project when the upgrades are completed.” The Applicant agrees to not interconnect until the system upgrades are complete and expects to hear from GMP when the substation is ready.
