Dear Ms. Anderson:

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the comments (“Comments”) filed by the Town of East Montpelier, VT (“the Town”) on April 19, 2021 regarding the net-metering application for rb Technologies, LLC (the “Applicant”) for a 44.2kW ground mount project in East Montpelier (the “Project”).

In its Comments, the Town indicated that the Project must comply with the following conditions in order to mitigate the Project’s impacts on the area:

1. “Maintenance of screening plantings: plantings put in place to mitigate the visual impact of the array shall be maintained as long as the array is in place. Any replacement plantings shall be native species.
2. Decommissioning: the applicant and any future owners should be required to decommission the project at the end of its life, returning the land to open space or developable land if the land has not been developed by that time (for example if a building was constructed on the site and the array moved to the roof).”

The Applicant agrees to comply with these requirements as requested by the Town.
