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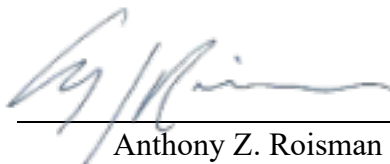
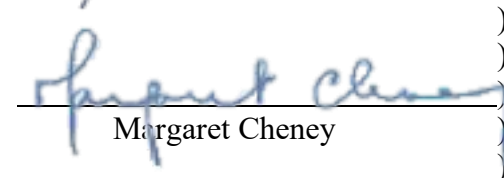

PROCEDURAL ORDER SETTING RESPONSE AND REPLY DEADLINES TO MOTION

On June 11, 2021, Vermont Legal Aid and the Vermont Public Interest Research Group filed a motion with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the temporary halt of involuntary utility disconnections be extended to August 31, 2021 (“the Motion”). Some participants have already responded to the Motion in the comments they filed on or before June 15, 2021, and those comments will be considered by the Commission in ruling on the Motion. Any further responses to the Motion must be filed **no later than Friday, June 18, 2021**, and any reply by the Movants must be filed **no later than Tuesday, June 22, 2021**.

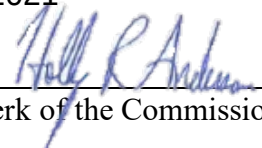
