Motion to Supplement the Evidentiary Record

Now come *pro se* Neighbor Intervenors Mark Slade, Joseph Charbonneau, Timothy Boucher, Glenn Cestaro and Cosmo Penge, and hereby move that the Public Utility Commission (“PUC”) admit three photos and one video into the record.

While cleaning up his computer, Glenn Cestaro found three photos of blocks of ice on the solar project site. The photos were taken on January 28, 2019.

In going through his phone, Timothy Boucher found a video taken on April 15, 2019 showing the flooding on the solar project site. That video was posted as an “other document” on ePUC today.

We think it is important for the PUC to see these photos and video to more fully understand the flooding and ice issues on the solar project site in our neighborhood.

WHEREFORE Neighbor Intervenors Slade, Charbonneau, Boucher, Cestaro and Penge respectfully move that three ice block photos in NI Exhibit A, and the flooding video posted today on ePUC be admitted into the evidentiary record.
