Separate Plant Issue Now Moot, Case Ready for Decision

Dear Ms. Anderson:

The Hearing Officer in the above-referenced matter issued a proposed decision concluding that the 500 kW (AC) facility proposed by Petitioner Putney Green Acres Solar LLC here was part of the same plant as a 150 kW (AC) facility proposed by Putney Blood Farm Solar LLC in Case No. 21-0651-NMP. The Commission subsequently decided to hold oral argument on the Hearing Officer's decision, which is now scheduled for August 25, 2021.

I am writing to notify the Commission that a stipulated dismissal was filed today by Putney Blood Farm Solar LLC pursuant to V.R.C.P. 41(a)(2) in Case No. 21-0651-NMP. A copy of the stipulated dismissal has been filed with this letter for the Commission's information. Therefore, the separate plant issue is now moot, and this case is ready for Commission action without the need for oral argument.

Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 8010(f), Petitioner anticipates a final Commission order on or before September 9, 2021, which is 90 days after June 11, 2021, the date of "the last substantive filing by a party" in this otherwise uncontested proceeding. See 30 V.S.A. § 8010(f) ("Except for net metering systems for which the Commission has established a registration process, the Commission shall issue a final determination as to an
