SECTION 6086 (a)(8) AESTHETICS, SCENIC BEAUTY, HISTORIC SITES AND NATURAL AREAS:

39. There are no historic sites or rare and irreplaceable natural areas which will be affected by this project. Exhibits 3, 46 and Testimony.
40. The Division for Historic Preservation indicates the project will not have an adverse impact on historic properties listed on or eligible for the National Register. Exhibit 46.
41. The existing site is a wooded hillside. The Applicants propose construction of 107-foot monopole with twelve, four-foot panel antennas, and a compound for the equipment at the base of the tower. There is space for a total of three carriers on the proposed tower. The utilities will be aboveground, crisscrossing the access road. Some clearing of brush and small trees for the utility lines and the road improvements will be necessary. Exhibits 3, 47 and Testimony.
42. The Applicants will disguise the pole to resemble a tree. The antennas will be painted green and hidden by the artificial branches. Exhibits 1 and 3.

Also attached is the Town and Regional preferred site letter, if helpful.
