Proposed revisions to Vermont Public Utility Commission Rule 5.100	
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**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMMENTS REGARDING PRESENTATIONS AT THE
SEPTEMBER 16, 2021, WORKSHOP**

On August 26, 2021, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a draft agenda for a September 16, 2021, workshop which will discuss how net-metered systems are compensated for their generation of electricity. That order also provided that requests to present at any workshop should be submitted by seven (7) days before the given workshop. The Vermont Department of Public (“Department”) will be in attendance to participate and provide commentary, or answer questions, but does not have a formal presentation planned. Previously, in this case and others, the Department has recommended various changes to net-metering compensation. These recommendations include revising the current compensation framework to reflect the corresponding economic benefit or detriment of a given system’s location within Vermont’s grid. The Department also looks forward to the presentation of Mr. Mark LeBel of the Regulatory Assistance Project.
