**GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. 2 LLC’S OPPOSITION TO CONSERVATION LAW
FOUNDATION, INC.’S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Petitioner GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. 2 LLC (“GLOBALFOUNDRIES”), by and through counsel, hereby opposes Intervener Conservation Law Foundation, Inc.’s (“CLF”) motion for summary judgment. In support of its opposition, GLOBALFOUNDRIES incorporates by reference its November 8, 2021 Initial Brief on Jurisdiction and Provision of Electricity to Tenants and its November 22, 2021 Reply Brief on Jurisdiction and Provision of Electricity to Tenants (together, “Jurisdictional Briefs”).

As explained in full in GLOBALFOUNDRIES’ Jurisdictional Briefs, the Commission has both express and implied jurisdiction to entertain GLOBALFOUNDRIES’ Petition for a Certificate of Public Good pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 231.
