Dear Ms. Anderson,

Pursuant to the Vermont Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Order in this docket dated 02/04/2022, the Town of Stowe Electric Department ("Stowe") submits this informational update. Stowe's submission includes an attached spreadsheet with facility-specific information for net-metering systems interconnected or proposed for interconnection to Stowe's system between 01/01/2020 and 02/01/2022.

Stowe interconnected 19 systems with a nameplate capacity of 176kW between 2020-2022. An additional 22 systems were proposed for interconnection between 2020-2022. Of the 13 net-metering systems that were proposed in 2019 but not yet interconnected at the time of the 2020 biennial update, 2 were interconnected to Stowe's distribution system.

Stowe looks forward to participating in the 2022 biennial update. We hope that the stakeholders involved can bring additional efficiencies to the net-metering application and interconnection process. Please let me know if you have any questions.
