Dear Ms. Anderson:

Starlink Services, LLC ("Starlink") provides this report in accordance with the Order Granting Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Designation ("ETC Order"), which was issued by the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") on May 3, 2021, in the above-referenced case. In the ETC Order, the Commission required Starlink to

file with the Commission and the Department any and all deployment milestone reports filed with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") during the period that it is receiving RDOF support, including the number of locations served with stand-alone voice in the applicable RDOF Census Blocks.

ETC Order ¶ 4a, at 12.

Starlink has not yet begun providing services in any of its Rural Digital Opportunity Fund ("RDOF") Census Blocks because the FCC has not yet granted Starlink's RDOF application. Accordingly, Starlink has not yet begun receiving RDOF funding or filing any deployment milestone reports with the FCC. Starlink continues to wait for FCC approval of its RDOF application to commence services.
