**AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD (“CPG”)
ISSUED PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) this day found and adjudged that an amendment to the CPG entered on April 16, 2016, in Docket No. 8596 and amended in Case No. 18-3449-PET on September 3, 2020, authorizing the construction and operation of the Salisbury Renewable Natural Gas Facility in Salisbury, Vermont (the “Project”) by Salisbury AD 1, LLC (“CPG Holder”), in accordance with the evidence submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State. Accordingly, the CPG entered on April 16, 2016, in Docket No. 8596 is amended as follows:

1. Condition 7 of the CPG is stricken in its entirety and replaced with:

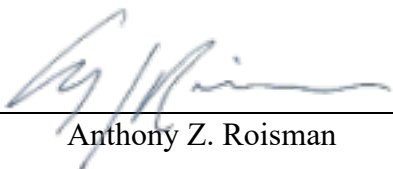
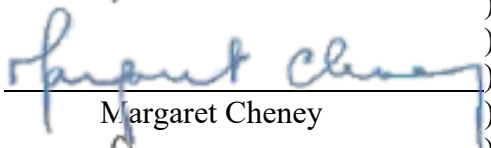
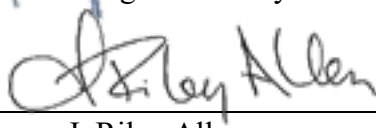
The CPG Holder shall restrict off-farm feedstock deliveries to the Amended Project to the hours between 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday, and 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. on Saturday, except that up to 10% of weekly deliveries may be made between the hours of 5:00 AM and 8:00 PM on any day of the week.

2. The CPG Holder shall pay all invoices (if any) from any State agency that (a) are related to this proceeding and (b) are not still under review by the Commission.

3. This Amendment to Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Commission.

The terms and conditions of the CPG entered on April 16, 2016, in Docket No. 8596, and as amended in Case No. 18-3449-PET shall remain in effect, except as modified above.

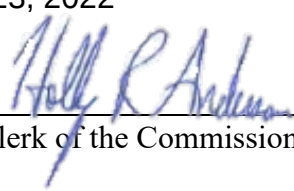
