ORDER AMENDING SCHEDULE

These cases concern GlobalFoundries U.S. 2 LLC’s (“GlobalFoundries”) petition for a certificate of public good, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 231, to operate an independent, self-managed utility beginning October 1, 2022, under *de minimis* regulation appropriate to its function and Green Mountain Power Corporation’s (“GMP”) petition for approval to modify its service territory, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 249.

After a scheduling conference held on May 9, 2022, the Commission adopted the parties’ proposed procedural schedule, with a few modifications.

On June 22, 2022, GlobalFoundries, AllEarth Renewables, Inc., and Conservation Law Foundation (collectively “Movants”) filed a stipulated motion to amend the schedule. The Movants represent that all parties have received a copy of the proposed amended schedule and do not object. On June 23, 2022, the Department of Public Service filed a response confirming that it does not object to the proposed amended schedule.

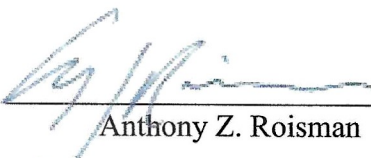
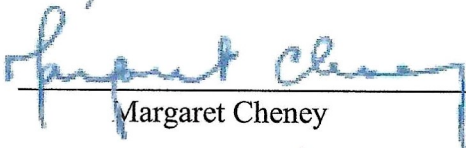
The Commission adopts the parties’ proposed amended schedule, below.

July 1, 2022	Deadline for Non-Petitioner supplemental prefiled testimony; any corrected or revised prefiled testimony; and, if not filing testimony, a list of outstanding issues that the party intends to pursue at the hearing other than those addressed in prefiled testimony
July 6, 2022	Discovery requests served on Non-petitioners; Commission information requests issued

July 25, 2022	Deadline for Non-petitioners' responses to discovery requests and Commission information requests
August 1, 2022	Deadline for parties to file (1) a joint proposal or proposals containing a schedule and order of witnesses for the hearing, each party's estimate of time it needs to cross-examine each witness, a list of issues that will be covered during a party's cross-examination, and any times during the hearing days that specific witnesses, if any, will not be available to testify; (2) a stipulated joint list of prefiled testimony; and (3) prehearing motions, including motions requesting the opportunity for direct examination of a witness and motions objecting to holding the evidentiary hearing remotely.
August 15, 2022 & August 17, 2022; August 18, 2022, if needed	Evidentiary hearings
September 5, 2022	Deadline for initial briefs
September 19, 2022	Deadline for reply briefs
