

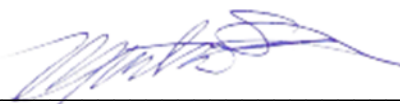

**Affidavit of Martha Staskus in Support of
Request for Waiver**

1. My name is Martha Staskus. I am the Chief Development Officer of Norwich Solar Technologies, Inc., which has an office at 15 Railroad Row, Suite 101, White River Junction, Vermont 05001. I have prepared and sponsored the net-metering application for a certificate of public good for a net-metering facility to be located at 0 Davis Road in Randolph, Vermont (the “Project”) on behalf of Randolph Davis Solar LLC (“Petitioner”).
2. As stated in my June 24, 2022 rebuttal testimony, on June 24, 2022, Petitioner submitted a revised Site Plan that extended the wetlands mapping on the Project site and reduced the Limit of Disturbance (“LOD”) to avoid the Class II wetlands and applicable wetland buffers as described in DoriBarton’s June 24, 2022 rebuttal testimony.
3. The LOD shift results in an approximately 80 foot movement (retraction) of the LOD’s northern most corner.
4. The LOD shift does not involve changing the Project capacity or the fuel source of the Project.
5. The LOD shift does not have the potential to have a significant impact under the applicable Section 248 criteria, and in fact reduces Project impacts.
