Starlink Services, LLC (“Starlink”) hereby informs the Vermont Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) that it has not yet been authorized to receive Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (“RDOF”) high-cost Universal Service Fund support by the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”).¹ Therefore, Starlink has not commenced services in the areas where it was granted designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) in Vermont. As such, Starlink is not yet required to file FCC Form 481 or any deployment milestone reports with the FCC. Starlink respectfully requests to remain an ETC in Vermont.
