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THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE’S RESPONSE TO PROCEDURAL ORDER

On July 21, 2022, the hearing officer issued a procedural order revising the schedule to extend the deadline for surrebuttal testimony in this matter. Under the schedule, the hearing officer requests that state agencies file an update to their comments if they elect not to file surrebuttal testimony.

The Department of Public Service (the “Department”) has reviewed the rebuttal testimony and accompanying exhibits filed by Michael Binder and Joan Allen (the “Intervenors”) and Randolph Davis Solar, LLC. The Department’s position as stated in its October 25, 2021 comments and June 24, 2022 supplemental comments remains unchanged. With respect to the concerns raised by the Intervenors regarding the proposed project’s impact on orderly development of the region, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248(b), the Department intends on addressing the issue in its brief following the evidentiary hearing.
