On September 2, 2022, the City of Burlington Electric Department (“BED”) filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) proposed revisions to its net-metering tariff to be effective October 1, 2022. On September 16, 2022, BED filed responses to a request for information issued by the Commission and the Department filed comments on BED’s initial filing. In its comments, the Department requested “the opportunity to comment on BED’s responses ... particularly regarding issues separate from, or auxiliary to, BED’s requested solar incentive change,” including BED’s proposed refund.¹

To ensure the Commission receives comments from the Department before the proposed revisions to the tariff are requested to go into effect, the Commission requests that the Department file any additional comments on the proposed tariff revisions on or before September 23, 2022. Additionally, the Commission requests that by the same date the Department comment on whether BED has sufficiently supplemented the record regarding its proposed refund to affected customers or whether the Department seeks additional information from BED regarding the refund.
