NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED SITE VISIT

This case involves an application filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) by Norwich Upper Loveland Solar, LLC (“Applicant”) for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) to construct and operate a 500 kW solar electric generation project in Norwich, Vermont (the proposed “Project”).

On September 27, 2022, I issued a scheduling order for the proceeding. Unfortunately, I have developed a conflict with a meeting before the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules on the date selected for the site visit, October 20, 2022.

On October 13, 2022, I issued a memorandum requesting alternative dates for the site visit. The Applicant responded stating that the Applicant and October 25, 2022, at 12:00 P.M. was a potentially suitable time. The Applicant also indicated that it had not received a response from the other parties and that the Applicant’s did not have any other availability until after the Thanksgiving holiday.

In view of the limited availability of the parties beyond October 25, the site visit is rescheduled for October 25, 2022, beginning at 12:00 P.M. The meeting location information for the site visit remains the same as described in the original notice issued on October 11, 2022, beginning at the cell tower access driveway (201 Upper Loveland Road, Norwich Vermont, coordinates 43.725342, -72.289842).
