MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SCHEDULE

Allco Renewable Energy Limited (“Allco”) hereby moves the Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) for a ten (10) day extension to file a proposed schedule for the penalty phase of this proceeding. On October 3, 2022, the Hearing Officer in these proceedings filed a Procedural Order requesting that Allco confer with the other parties and file a proposed schedule for the penalty phase of this proceeding by no later than Friday, October 21, 2022. On October 13, 2022, the Vermont Agency of Agriculture Food and Markets as well as the Town of Bennington confirmed that they will not be participating in the penalty phase of the proceedings. On October 17, 2022, Allco discussed the schedule with the Vermont Department of Public Service (“DPS”). On October 18, 2022, Allco discussed the schedule with the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (“ANR”). Allco, DPS and ANR need some additional time to agree on the appropriate path forward with respect to the penalty phase of these proceedings and, as such, Allco is hereby respectfully requesting an additional ten (10) days to file a schedule.
