VERMONT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE PROPOSED SCHEDULE

On November 16, 2022, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order opening an investigation in to Sections V.F.(5) and (6) of the City of Burlington Electric Department’s (“BED”) net-metering tariff. That order also granted intervention to Renewable Energy Vermont Incorporated (“REV”) and established that a scheduling conference for this investigation would be held on December 2, 2022. At the conference, the parties agreed to file either a consensus schedule or separate schedules by December 16, 2022. The Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) has worked with BED to propose the following schedule. The Department has shared a draft of the schedule with BED and REV and understands that each are agreeable to this proposed schedule.

January 17, 2023	Party Information Requests and Requests for Production upon BED Due
January 24, 2023	PUC Information Requests on BED
February 10, 2023	BED Files Answers and Produces Requested Files
February 28, 2023	BED files V.R.C.P. 56 Motion for Summary Judgment on its net-metering tariff’s compliance with Vermont statute and Commission Rule.
March 30, 2023	Parties Respond to V.R.C.P. 56 Motion
April 13, 2023	BED files reply in support of Motion for Summary Judgment
Within 14 days of Commission ruling on Motion for Summary Judgment	Parties submit status update and proposals for additional process as necessary
