**PROCEDURAL ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSE TO MOTION TO STRIKE**

This case involves an application filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) by Norwich Upper Loveland Solar, LLC (“Applicant”) for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) to construct and operate a 500 kW solar electric generation project in Norwich, Vermont (the proposed “Project”).


On December 15, 2022, the Applicant filed a motion to strike certain portions of the prefiled testimony and exhibits filed by intervening parties Stephen Gorman, Jenn Goulet, and Joy Kenseth.

Rule 7(b)(4) of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure states that “[a] memorandum in opposition to any nondispositive motion shall be filed not more than 14 days after service of the motion, unless otherwise ordered by the court.” The standard fourteen-day period would require responses to the Applicant’s motion by December 29, 2022.

In consideration of the number of *pro se* parties in this case and to avoid interference with any parties’ holiday plans, the deadline for responses to the Applicant’s motion to strike is extended until January 9, 2023.
