**VERMONT AGENCY OF NATURAL RESOURCES MOTION TO CHANGE  
SCHEDULE**

On December 14, 2022, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a procedural order denying the motion filed by Allco Renewable Energy Limited and its affiliates (collectively, “Allco”) to stay these proceedings. The Commission requested that the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (“Agency”) confer with the parties and file a proposed schedule for the penalty phase of this proceeding by Friday, December 29, 2022. The Agency now requests that the date for filing a proposed schedule for the penalty phase of this proceeding be changed to Friday, January 13, 2023.

Counsel for the Agency will be out of the office from December 26, 2022, through January 2, 2023. Adjusting the filing date to January 13 will allow time for the parties to confer on a proposed schedule taking into consideration the approaching holidays and counsel’s scheduled time out of the office. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for Allco and the Department of Public Service and is authorized to represent those parties consent to this request.
