SCHEDULING ORDER

On November 16, 2022, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order opening an investigation into Sections V.F.(5) and (6) of the City of Burlington Electric Department’s (“BED”) net-metering tariff.

On December 2, 2022, I held a scheduling conference in this matter. Appearances were entered by Alexander Wing, Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”); William F. Ellis, McNeil, Leddy & Sheahan, on behalf of BED; and Jonathan Dowds, Renewable Energy Vermont (“REV”).

After the scheduling conference, the parties developed the following proposed procedural schedule. The Department filed the schedule on December 16, 2022, and stated that both BED and REV agreed to the proposed schedule. I hereby adopt the proposed schedule.

January 24, 2023	Commission Information Requests on BED
February 10, 2023	BED Files Answers and Produces Requested Files
February 28, 2023	BED files Motion for Summary Judgment on its net-metering tariff’s compliance with Vermont statute and Commission Rule
March 30, 2023	Parties Respond to Motion for Summary Judgment
April 13, 2023	BED files reply in support of Motion for Summary Judgment
Within 14 days of Commission ruling on Motion for Summary Judgment	Parties submit status update and proposals for additional process, as necessary

Please note that the Commission’s revised procedural rules (Commission Rule 2.000) will take effect on January 18, 2023. The new version of Commission Rule 2.000 will apply to

Parties are reminded that documents submitted in .pdf format should be in an “unlocked” format, i.e., searchable and extractable, rather than in an image format.

Members of the public interested in this proceeding may participate by submitting public comments or by intervening as a formal party to the case. Members of the public may also simply monitor the Commission’s actions in a specific case. Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 20 and 21, BED will be responsible for court reporter costs incurred by the Commission during the course of this proceeding and billed back to BED.

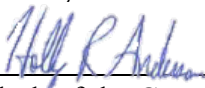
