CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ("CPG") ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 231

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Vermont Public Service Board ("Board") this day found and adjudged that the proposal of Lincoln Renewable Gas, LLC ("CPG Holder"), to own and operate a renewable natural gas facility with a plant capacity of up to 130,000 m.c.f. in Salisbury, Vermont (the "Project"), will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 231, a certificate of public good, subject to the conditions below, shall be issued to the CPG Holder for the ownership and operation of the Project, as described in the supporting testimony and exhibits submitted with the petition in this proceeding.
2. The CPG Holder shall at all times conduct its operations consistent with applicable Board rules or regulations, as amended from time to time, with this CPG, and with Vermont law.
3. The CPG Holder shall notify the Board and the Department within 14 days of any changes in the ownership of entities involved in the operation of the Project under 30 V.S.A. § 231.
4. The CPG Holder shall not transfer ownership of the Project without prior approval of the Board.
5. This CPG shall be subject to revocation upon good cause, including a substantial or continuous failure by the CPG Holder to abide by the terms herein.

This CPG shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
