Dear Customer Name,

Burlington Electric Department (BED) previously provided you with a notice dated January 12, 2023, that you would be receiving a solar incentive bill credit during the month of January or February 2023. This credit was authorized by the Public Utility Commission (Commission) in its November 16, 2022, Order in Case No. 22-3947-TF. The credit covered the period of time from August 1, 2021, to September 30, 2022, during which BED had been providing a solar incentive of \$0.041185 per kWh instead of \$0.052265 per kWh.

The Department of Public Service also proposed several text changes to BED's net-metering tariff in Case No. 22-3947-TF. The Commission issued a final order on these changes on May 1, 2023, and BED filed with the Commission on May 15, 2023, a revised net-metering tariff that reflects these changes. In this revised tariff, pre-existing net-metering customers who receive a solar incentive retain the ability to request cash outs for credit balances of \$100 and greater and to accumulate credit balances from year to year.
