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**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE RESPONSE TO BURLINGTON
ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT'S PROPOSED CUSTOMER NOTICE AND
TARIFF REDLINE**

On May 1, 2023, the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("Commission") issued an order granting the City of Burlington Electric Department's ("BED") motion for summary judgement, thereby approving Sections V.F. (5) and (6) of the BED's net-metering tariff. The order directed BED to make specific changes to the text of its net-metering tariff and recommended that BED consult with the Vermont Department of Public Service ("Department") regarding an accompanying customer notice. On May 15, 2023, BED filed corresponding changes to its net-metering tariff and a customer notice that it discussed with the Department. Accordingly, the Department recommends approval of BED's revised net-metering tariff and proposed customer notice.
