Dear Ms. Anderson:

Pursuant to the Commission's order in the above-referenced case, GF Power LLC ("GF Power") respectfully submits the following in response to the Commission's questions:

1. The approximate date that you expect to file your tariffs with the Commission. **ANSWER:** This was completed with the tariff approved by the Commission effective January 1, 2023. The tariff offers GlobalFoundries a formula rate which is essentially a direct pass-through of all costs and benefits of GlobalFoundries' management of loads. As such, GF Power already meets the objective of Act 55 to encourage efficient integration of PEVs and EVSE into the electric system and the timely adoption of PEVs and public charging through managed loads or time-differentiated price signals.
2. Whether you will file multiple EVSE tariffs, and to which rate classes, market segments, or customer segments those rates will apply. **ANSWER:** GF Power does not plan to file multiple EVSE tariffs as it has only one customer and the approved tariff is sweeping in its scope.
3. Progress barriers that you are encountering that could prevent you from meeting the requirements of Sections (a) and (b) of Act 55 and possible solutions to overcoming those barriers. **ANSWER:** To date, GF Power has not identified any progress barriers to meeting the requirements of Act 55
4. Whether you already offer an EVSE rate that qualifies for the exemption of Act 55, Section (d). Please identify the rate class, market segment, or customer segment to which the exemption applies. **ANSWER:** GF Power does not qualify for the exemption of Act 55 Section (d) as it did not have rates approved by the Public Utility Commission prior to July 1, 2021.
5. Whether you expect to request an extension under Act 55, Section (e), with respect to any of the EVSE rate classes, market segments, or customer segments. **ANSWER:**

Assuming the PUC concurs with GF Power's position that its current tariff meets the requirements of Act 55, GF Power does not expect to seek an extension under Act 55 Section (e).

6. Suggested topics for additional workshops or written filings. **ANSWER:** GF Power does not have suggested topics for additional workshops or written filings at this time.
