

VERMONT ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC.  
FLEXIBLE LOAD HOME CHARGING PROGRAM

This tariff is adopted to comply with Act 55, Section 33(b) which requires all State electric distribution utility to offer rates for electric vehicle charging no later than June 30, 2024.

1. Applicability. Participation in this program is optional and available only to those residential customers who are Vermont residents and who own or lease a plug-in hybrid or fully electric vehicle.
2. Eligibility. To be eligible for this program, the customer must have a compatible level II charger and/or vehicle and enroll their charger or vehicle in VEC's communications platform, which enables VEC to request that the vehicle not charge during times when VEC is expecting peak demand. These events will last no longer than five hours. Participants will be notified prior to the event and will be able to opt out of individual events. VEC members who elect Service Classification 1.2, Residential Time-of-Use Pilot Rate, are eligible to participate in this program. They are eligible to receive the enrollment incentive but not the ongoing monthly incentive because the time of use rate already provides compensation for peak-shifting.
3. Compensation. Participants will receive an enrollment incentive of either a free home level II charger or a \$50 bill credit, which will be applied to the bill issued the month following VEC's confirmation of enrollment. Thereafter, participants will receive a bill credit of \$8 per month provided that they do not opt out of any events that month
4. Term of Participation. Customers choosing to enroll in this program shall remain enrolled for a minimum of twelve months.
