ORDER CLOSING CASE

On April 16, 2016, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a Certificate of Public Good (“CPG”) pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248 in Docket No. 8596, authorizing the construction and operation of a renewable natural gas facility in Salisbury, Vermont. The CPG was later amended twice in Case No. 18-3449-PET.

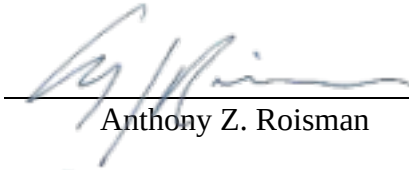
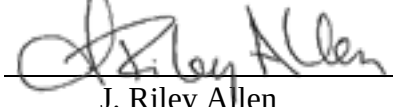
On April 7, 2022, Salisbury AD 1, LLC filed a petition to amend the CPG for a third time. The petition was assigned Case No. 22-1168-PET.

On June 23, 2022, the Commission issued an order in Case No. 22-1168-PET amending the CPG. Therefore, this case, Case No. 8596, is closed.

All future compliance filings required by the CPG issued in Case No. 8596 and amended in Case Nos. 18-3449-PET and 22-1168-PET must be made in the compliance subcase of Case No. 22-1168-PET. Parties in this case will be made parties in Case No. 22-1168-PET for the purposes of receiving notices of future compliance filings and an opportunity to file comments on those filings.

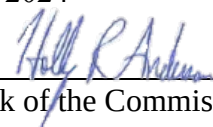
