Essex A North Lot Solar, LLC (Petitioner) certifies that, on August 1, 2023 it satisfied the Advance Notice requirements of Commission Rule 5.402 according to the requirements of the Rule as it applied at that time. In addition, on that same date, the Petitioner sent the 45-day advance notice to the Department of Public Service, Agency of Natural Resources, the interconnecting utility Green Mountain Power, host landowner GlobalFoundries, Agency of Agricultural, Food & Markets, Department of Historic Preservation, and the Natural Resources Board. Subsequent to said notice, Petitioner received comments on the Project and has responded to the same through direct engagement with commenters and/or the contents of its Petition filing. Based on these facts, Petitioner has been advised by the Public Utility Commission Clerk that no additional notice requirements must be met notwithstanding the amendments to Rule 5.400 effective March 1, 2024.
